Policies and Procedures

Drop off & pick up Policy:

Please drop off and pick up campers in the designated area. Drop off is 8:30 to 9:00 AM and pick up is 12:30 for Half Day and 3:00 for full day campers. There is a \$2 per 5 minutes late fee for picking your camper after 12:45 (for Half Day Campers) and 3:15 (for Full Day Campers). This is payable in cash directly to the coach who has to stay late for your child. We do not provide before or after care. Please be timely when dropping off and picking up to avoid the late fee!

Cancellation / Refund Policy:

There are no refunds for cancellations for any reason after June 1st! Rescheduling is permitted with a 20% administrative charge and must be rescheduled by Week #10, after which there are no refunds or rescheduling.

Disciplinary Policy:

We utilize "Time-Outs" as the means of discipline and the parent will be notified. If a camper does not respond after 2 timeouts in any given day; a parent conference will be scheduled or the parent will be notified to have the child picked up from camp. If the behavior does not improve, we reserve the right to expel the child from camp (with no refund of the balance of the camp fees for that week).

Sunblock Policy:

Sunblock must be applied to your camper at least 30 minutes prior to arrival at camp! Each camper is required to bring 1 bottle of sunblock to camp each week. Coaches will reapply or assist in reapplying the sunblock during the morning break and again during the afternoon rest period. AquaKids is not responsible for Sunburns! Please send a Dermatologist approved Water Proof Child Sunblock with a minimum 30 SPF!

Equipment Bag:

Please bring all camper items (clearly marked with his/her name) in an equipment bag or backpack. Items to bring are listed in the camp brochure and at www.aquakidsswim.com on the camp pages.

Lost or Stolen Items:

AquaKids is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. We have a lost and found container at the pool. All items in this container will be donated to the Homeless Family Shelter at the end of each week of camp.

Water / Hydration:

All campers are required to bring a water/sports bottle filled with water or a sports beverage. This does not include sodas. Camp will provide cold water to refill the camper drink container during camp as needed.

Weather Conditions and Procedure:

Should a weather condition force us to clear the pool, pool deck, and/or any other outside area where we are conducting an activity, all campers will be kept indoors and provided with inside activities until the weather improves.
